## The Arvada Center Reaching for the Arts Scholarship Program

The Arvada Center for the Arts and Humanities offers classes, workshops and camps in the areas of Drama, Dance, Visual Arts and Music. We offer classes in five sessions per year and accept scholarship applications prior to each session of classes. Scholarship awards are given for either full or partial tuition, with an emphasis being made on full scholarship awards.

#### **Scholarship Awards**

Scholarships are available for all ages, children through adults, and are awarded in recognition of financial need and talent. Selections for scholarship awards are made through review of applications and a submitted letter of recommendation. Scholarship grants are to be applied toward one class, workshop or camp and must be used for the session(s) for which they are granted. Students receiving awards will be mailed an award letter and should register for the class, workshop or camp in person at the Arvada Center Box Office or by calling the Box Office 720-898-7200. Students are encouraged to register immediately upon receiving their award letter as some classes have limited availability.
